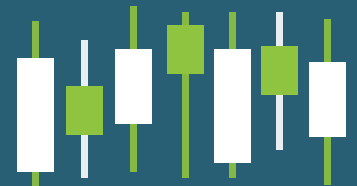

## Volunteer Roles

VOLUNTEERS CAN SIGN UP FOR EITHER THE STUDENT (8:30 AM - 1:30 PM)  
OR CORPORATE COMPETITION (4:30 PM - 8:30 PM)

**Floor Trader:** these volunteers are responsible for moving around the trading floor with a tablet set up for trading. Floor Traders will conduct buy and sell orders for participating teams. They must respond as quickly as possible to students' requests to place orders.

- *These volunteers should be comfortable using a tablet and working quickly to execute trades.*
- *This role is fast-paced and requires periods of standing, walking, and frequent movement throughout the competition.*
- *Volunteer training is provided and JA staff will be on-site to assist you.*

**News Runner:** these volunteers distribute the newsletters and alerts at strategic intervals throughout the competition.

- *Create a station for News Runners to have a "home-base" where all printed newsletters and alerts are stored away from the view of participants.*
- *This role will have periods of standing and sitting.*
- *Volunteer training is provided and JA staff will be on-site to assist you.*

**Print Station Attendant:** these volunteers will remain at the print station(s) throughout the competition and will use a computer and printer to provide students with an up-to-date copy of their team's portfolio.

- *This role may have periods of fast-paced work and periods of downtime; this is a stationary role and the volunteer will not be required to move around the space.*
- *Participating teams are provided with a number of tickets equal to the number of portfolio printouts they can obtain throughout the competition (e.g. three tickets for three portfolio printouts) to see an updated copy of their portfolio report.*
- *Volunteer training is provided and JA staff will be on-site to assist you.*
